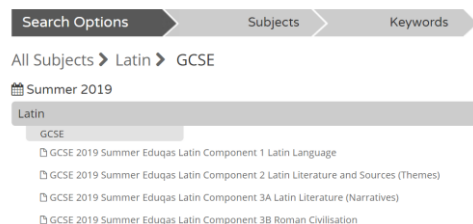
The Principal Examiners' reports provide helpful observations and commentary on candidates' performance across the examined series.

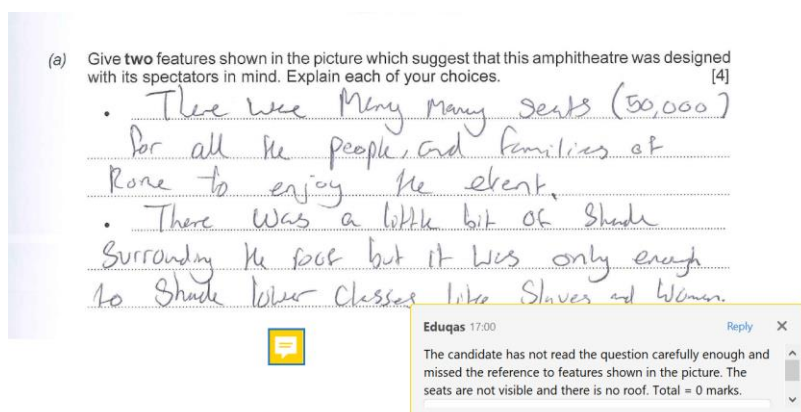
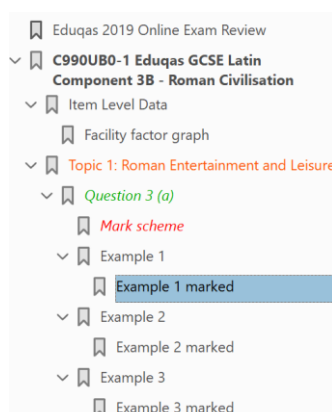
5. Online Exam Review (Marked Exemplar)
